- c) A table



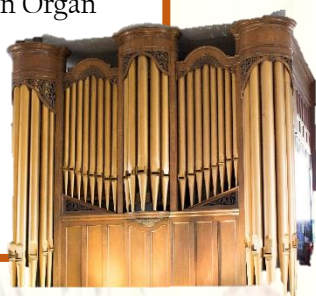
